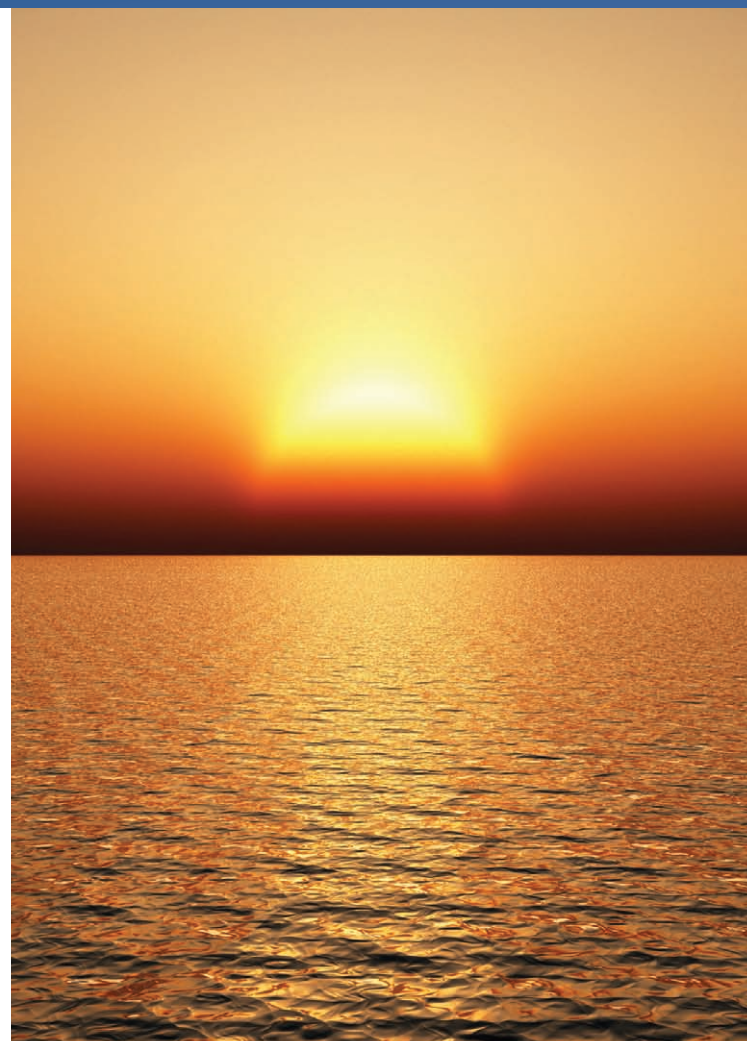
Well Abandonment
